Eligibility

The competition is open to all purchasers of books in the series Star of Deltora, by Emily Rodda. This includes students, Scholastic Book Club Organisers and Teachers from registered, participating schools in Australia as well as members of the general public. The promotion is open to Australian and New Zealand residents only.

Details of Prizes:

Method of entry

There are four ways a participant may enter to win as part of this promotion.

Method 1: Instant Win Cards

There are Instant Win cards randomly inserted into copies of books released in the series. Each card has a unique code on its reverse face.

To redeem Instant Win cards, entrants go online to www.scholastic.com.au/starofdeltora and enter the unique code. Upon entry of details and unique code, a Scholastic Book Club voucher to the value of \$5 will be supplied to the winner.

Scholastic Book Club vouchers may be redeemed through Scholastic Book Clubs and Fairs in school or may be redeemed online via Books Clubs or the Scholastic online store <http://shop.scholastic.com.au>.

The winner will be required to enter contact and mailing details so that the prize may be supplied by post.

Method 2: Collectors' Poster Prize Draw

The design on the reverse of the collector cards may be formed into an image from the book.

A Collector's poster is available from select outlets and through schools so that participants can identify what cards they need to collect to form the image

Entrants who submit a photograph of the completed Collector's poster with all 20 slots filled and with the secret image completed will go into a draw to win one of three prize packs. Submission of the photo and contact details are made online at www.scholastic.com.au/starofdeltora

Scholastic may request selected winners to authenticate their poster by asking the poster to be submitted to Scholastic by mail. In the event that the participant is unable to supply a complete poster for verification, the entitlement to a prize will be forfeited.

Method 3: Grand Prize Draw

There are four foiled collectable cards. The reverse of these cards feature a two digit alphanumeric code.

To enter the Grand Prize Draw, the participant must:

- Submit the unique codes from all four designs of foiled card
- Submit a photo of their completed Collector's poster with all 20 slots filled (the slots filled must correspond to the positions on the poster and form the secret image)
- Submit their contact details.

The winner will be picked by random draw from the eligible entrants. Random draw is conducted by computerised picking system.

All entries will be considered.

Method 4: Foiled Cards Collectors' Draw/'Crack the Code' – referred to as 'Surprise Draw'

There are four foiled collectable cards. The reverse of these cards feature a two digit alphanumeric code.

To enter the Foiled Cards Collectors' Draw, the participant must:

- Submit the unique codes from all four designs of foiled card in the correct sequence
- Submit their contact details.

Duration of promotion

Place and Time of Judging

The judge's decision will be considered as final and no correspondence shall be entered into.

Publication of results
